

# ARP HEERF III DISCLOSURE

## Public Notice

### Update ARP HEERF III Grant Q-1 2022

1. Academy of Massage & Bodywork, Ltd. (AMB) has applied for and signed and returned to the US Department of Education the Certification and Agreement to accept allocated funds from the **American Rescue Plan (ARP)**, Public Law 117-2, and the assurance that the institution will disburse the financial aid grants solely to Students. The institution may not and did not use any of these funds for any other purpose. The ARP established and funded the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III (HEERF III) to provide emergency financial aid grants. These critical funds help eligible AMB students cover expenses related to unanticipated travel, additional technology requirements, or other needs related to an emergency situation.
2. The total amount of the funds that the institution has received from the Department pursuant to the Institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants ARP HEERF III to Students is **\$32,537.00**.
3. The total amount of the Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under ARP HEERF III as of the date of submission (as of the report this quarter – Quarter 1 2022) \$16,268.50 for the 1st disbursement on December 27, 2021. Report of this first disbursement posted January 10, 2022.
4. **No Disbursements were made during Q-1 2022.** Academy of Massage & Bodywork (AMB) was permitted to only draw down one half of the ARP HEERF III Award at a time. AMB elected to award the other half of ARP Grant monies to the next cohort. The COVID-19 Pandemic has not been declared over by the US Government and hardships will continue with students considering the rising cost of fuel and commuting costs for AMB's students. AMB is a commuter school.
